Recent Wins Thanks to Philanthropy

- Led by Dr. Gary Ulaner, James & Pamela Muzzy Endowed Chair in Molecular Imaging and Therapy, Hoag became the first site worldwide to enroll patients in two prostate cancer clinical trials, providing unique imaging and therapy options not yet available at most cancer centers.
- Enhancing Hoag's cancer research team, philanthropy enabled Hoag to welcome Drs. Monica and Alain Mita from Cedars-Sinai as co-directors of early phase drug development.
- In partnership with the Orange County Fire Authority, Dr. Steven Wang used philanthropy-funded technology to provide precise skin cancer screenings for local firefighters, improving detection through advanced imaging tools.
