# Supporting Outstanding Care

We are moved and inspired by the magnitude of what we've accomplished together on behalf of cancer patients in our community. You will be pleased to know that funds raised in 2013 were designated to the following areas in the Hoag Family Cancer Institute (HFCI):

#### \$650,000 - Gamma Knife Radiation Source Renewal

After five years, the Gamma Knife radiation source decays and loses strength, which increases the time needed for treatment. For example, if a treatment (at normal strength) requires two hours, it can require four hours when the source is not at full strength. These funds will allow HFCI to renew its exhausted radiation source to increase comfort and convenience for patients.

#### \$80,000 - Create an Innovation Fund for Cancer Patient Survivorship and Thrivership

This new Innovation Fund will assist Hoag in developing leading-edge approaches to cancer survivorship and thrivership including psychosocial support for patients following treatment.

#### \$100,000 – Sandy Sewell Endowed Oncology Nursing Scholarship

The Sandy Sewell Oncology Scholarship assists Hoag in increasing the overall education and skill level of Hoag nurses and the number of nurses that are specialized in oncology.

#### \$50,000 - Annual Oncology Nursing Conference

Funds will help finance Hoag's annual Oncology Nursing Conference, a key educational opportunity that addresses practical issues and clinical challenges to an audience of radiation and oncology nurses from all over the western United States, as well as pharmacists and nursing students interested in specializing in oncology.

We are deeply grateful to our donors who, embracing the vision of supporting outstanding cancer care, have made a real and lasting impact.


